Saskatchewan is home to one of the world's largest pulse and plant-based protein sectors.

Home to 40% of Canada's farmland

Saskatchewan grows the food the world needs and is home to more than 40% of Canada's farmland.

The province has released over 500 new commercial varieties of more than 40 different crop types.

Our Competitive Edge

- Saskatchewan exports \$20 billion in agri-food annually and is home to more than 300 food processors. Recently Saskatchewan has seen more than a billion dollars in investment in new canola crushing and pea processing.
- Saskatchewan is world-renowned as an innovative manufacturing cluster of high-quality, safe, sustainable agricultural products, including ingredients for a variety of health foods such as plant-based alternatives, cereals, beverages, and baked goods.
- Saskatchewan is a global leader in production of lentils, dry peas and chickpeas, meeting demand for new products and more plant-based foods.
- Saskatchewan has industry leading organizations such as the Saskatchewan Food Industry Development Centre, the Global Institute for Food Security, and Saskatchewan's Crop Development Centre.
- Saskatchewan is one of the first jurisdictions to convert to no-till farming, and has the highest percentage of zero or minimum tillage crops in Canada.

Program and Incentives

Saskatchewan Value-Added Agriculture Incentive

A non-transferable 15% tax rebate on capital expenditures valued at \$10 million or more for newly constructed or expanded value-added agriculture facilities in Saskatchewan.

Product Development Program

Provides funding for prototype and product development services to food, beverage and other agri-processing value-added companies.

Saskatchewan Lean Improvements in Manufacturing

Provides funding to agri-businesses for infrastructure projects that improve productivity and efficiency.

Ag-tech Growth Fund

Provides a non-repayable grant to projects that provide game-changing technological innovations in the province's agriculture sector.
