# Our Competitive Edge

- Saskatchewan is a mining powerhouse, contributing significantly to global potash and uranium production with the world's largest reserves of potash and high-grade uranium.
- Saskatchewan's rich resource portfolio encompasses 27 of Canada's critical minerals, vital for modern living and a sustainable and secure future.
- Saskatchewan is a rare earth element hub and home to the first minerals-to-metals rare earth processing facility in North America.
- The province supports a transparent, stable regulatory environment and easy access to high-quality, pre-competitive geoscience information.
- Driven by *Securing the Future: Saskatchewan's Critical Minerals Strategy*, the province aims to double the number of critical minerals produced by 2030.

# Program and Incentives

## Saskatchewan Critical Minerals Innovation Incentive (SCMII)

Supports innovation commercialization projects that target emerging critical minerals including helium, lithium, rare earth elements, copper, zinc, magnesium, cobalt, natural graphite, nickel, gallium and aluminum through a 25% transferable royalty/freehold production tax credit.

## Critical Minerals Processing Investment Incentive (CMPII)

Provides a 15% transferable royalty/freehold production tax credit to support the development of processing facilities for 11 emerging critical minerals in Saskatchewan.

## Saskatchewan Mineral Exploration Tax Credit (SMETC)

A non-refundable 30% tax credit for Saskatchewan taxpayers investing in eligible mineral exploration flow-through shares.

## Targeted Mineral Exploration Incentive (TMEI)

Offers a 25% grant for hard-rock mineral exploration drilling costs anywhere in the province.
